And at every turn, human plans seem to be in control— Jewish leaders manipulating, Roman authority judging but John wants us to know something greater: Every step was fulfilling God's divine purpose, so that you may believe Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and have life in His name (John 20:31).

1 Religious Hypocrisy vs. God's Sovereignty (John 18:28)

- Jewish leaders avoid ceremonial defilement... while plotting murder
- Appearances over heart change
- · God is orchestrating even their hypocrisy for His plan

2 Pilate's Question: Earthly Power Meets Divine Purpose (John 18:29-30)

- Pilate demands charges: Leaders give vague accusations
- People still reject Jesus without understanding Him
- Jesus' mission unfolds regardless of human authority

3 Human Limitations, Divine Fulfillment (John 18:31)

Jews say: "We cannot legally put anyone to death"

- Roman law forces crucifixion, not stoning
- Jesus' prophecy (John 12:32) is fulfilled: "Lifted up"

4 God's Signature on the Cross (John 18:32)

- Every trial detail fulfills Jesus' words
- Jesus is not a victim—He's victor!
- Purposeful death \rightarrow offers YOU life
